INSTRUCTIONS

1. Admit Card has been issued only to ensure appearance in the written examination, your eligibility will be verified at the time of interview. The question paper will be in the form of objective multiple choice consisting of 100 questions, one mark each with duration of two hours. There will be NO negative marking.
2. You are requested to be present in the examination centre one hour before the start of examination; Bioinformatics Examination 10:00- 12:00 PM and Microbiology 2:00 PM to 4:00PM.
3. Entry in the examination centre will be closed 15 minutes before the start of examination. Candidates will **NOT** be allowed to enter the examination centre after examination starts.
4. You will not be allowed to leave the examination hall before completion of examination and handing over the question booklet/answer sheets to the invigilator.
5. Still photography will also be done during the examination and 10 minutes extra time will be given to the candidates.
6. Candidates are required to bring Black/Blue ball point pen as all entries in the answer sheet should be made with the black or blue ball point pen only.
7. You need to bring at least one original (not photocopied/scanned copy) and valid (not expired) photo identification. The name on your photo identification (Passport/ Voter ID/ PAN card/ UID card/ driving license) must match your name as entered in the application form indicating date of birth and residential address. Candidates will not be permitted to take test if Photo ID is not presented or if there is a mismatch.
8. Mobile/ Cell Phones/ Pagers/ Calculators & any other unauthorized electronic gadgets are NOT allowed in the Examination Room/ Hall. Candidates have to make his/ her own arrangements for keeping these items in safe custody, if brought. School/ Centre will not be held responsible for these items, if lost/damage.
9. Candidates are advised to put their signature at the time of examination exactly in the same way as signed in the application form. Any variation in the signatures at any stage of selection will render their candidature liable for cancellation.
10. Rough work can be done on question paper itself and not on any other sheet/paper.
11. No TA will be paid for appearing in the written examination on 14.08.2016.
